

The Commissioners' court in and for Sabine County met in Special Session May 2nd, 1936, with the following members present, to-wit: Edw. Harper, County Judge, T. R. Smith, Commr. Prect. No. 1, E. C. Smith, Commr. Prect. No. 2, P.H. McGown, Commr. Prect. No. 3, R.W. Chapman, Commr. Prect. No. 4, Geo. W. Russell, Sheriff, and Zeda Davidson, Clerk and transacted business as follows:

Accounts were allowed and approved as is shown by Minutes of Accounts allowed.

On motion by P.H. McGown, seconded by E. C. Smith, it is ordered by the court that Johnny Morgan, be appointed Case Worker for Sabine County, at the sum of \$100.00 per month, to be paid from proceeds of sale of articles turned over to Sabine County by the Texas Relief Commission.

On this day came on to be considered the fact that while canvassing the returns of the School Elections for Trustees, there were reported on the minutes of the Court that Anna B. Clark, Clifton Mitchell and Henry S. Frisby received the highest number of votes and were thereby elected trustee for the Fairmount School, when in truth and in fact Lamar Smith received more votes than Henry S. Frisby, and thereby was elected trustee.

The Court hereby declares an error in the returns of the election on the minutes of the Commissioners' court and declares that the three highest votes were cast for Anna B. Clark, Lamar Smith, and Clifton Mitchell, respectfully, thereby electing them as Trustee for Fairmount School No. 15.
