

The Commissioners court reconvened as a board of Equalization, on this the 16th day of June, after raising and lowering taxes and renditions, as they saw fit, with all members present, and after being in session for two days/closed the board of equalization, and set the date of hearing for said board on the 6th day of July, 1936.

The same day the Court met as a Commissioners' court and transacted business as follows:

Fund, be cancelled and scrip in lieu thereof be issued on the same fund out of the same fund, for the same purpose but in sums of \$36.96, \$15.05, and \$5.95. Said scrip being No. 1178 issued in favor of First National Bank of San Augustine, for Depository interest.
