Russell, Sheriff, and Zeda Davidson, County Clerk, and transacted business as follows:

Accounts were allowed and approved as is shown by Minutes of Accounts allowed.

10. On motion of P. H. McGown, seconded by R. W. Chapman, with McGown, Chapman, & E. C. Smith voting in favor of said motion, it is ordered by the court that the heirs of J. T. McGown, and Lula McGown, deceased, to-wit: A. L. McGown, Sr., A. L. McGown, Jr., Ida Jones, Mattie Speights, Mable Kounce, J. P. McGown, Lou McGown, and Lauree Drawhorn, and Lula T. Hunter, heirs of Sally Drawhorn, deceased, be paid the sum of \$200.00, divided into eight parts for the 100 Ft. right-of-way on Highway 21, in Sabine County, Texas, running through the J. T. McGown homestead on the James Gains league as now located and being 100 ft. wide and extending a distance

of 450 ft. from the Sabine River. Together with an easement on a 23 acres, more or less, on said land, to be used as a detour to the temporary bridge to be constructed for use during construction of the new Sabine River Bridge on State Highway 21.

It is further ordered in this connection that in event the State Highway Department find it necessary and require the removal of the residence now situated on the North or West side of said highway, then and in that event, said residence shall be removed in accordance with such orders and left in good condition as it now is at Sabine County's expense.
