H. McGown, Commr. Prec. No. 3, R. W. Chapman, Commr. Prec. No. 4, and Geo. W. Russell, Sheriff and Zeda Davidson, Clerk, and transacted business as follows, to-wit:

It further appearing that said District does not embrace any territory that was taken from any other school district (either common or independent) that had an outstanding issue of bonds at the date of such inclusion in this District:

They shall bear interest at the rate of four (4%) per cent per annum, payable on the 10th day of April, 1937, and annually thereafter on the 10th day of April of each year.

V.

Principal and interest shall be payable upon presentation and surrender of bonds or proper coupons in lawful money of the United States of America, at the Office of the Treasurer of the State of Texas, at Austin, Texas, or at the office of the County Treasurer of Sabine County, Texas, at the option of the holder.

Said bonds shall be signed by the County Judge, countersigned by the County Clerk and registered by the County Treasurer, and the seal of the Commissioners court shall be impressed
