

Be it remembered, that the Commissioners' court of Sabine County, Texas, met in Special Session at the courthouse on the 30th day of November, 1936, the following present, Edward Harper, County Judge, T. R. Smith, Commissioner, Precinct No. 1, R. W. Chapman, Commissioner, Precinct No. 4; Zeda Davidson, County Clerk, and Geo. W. Russell, Sheriff, when the following proceedings were had:

This the 30th day of November, A. D. 1936, it having been made known to the court by the Tax Collector of Sabine County, "that for the year 1920, one thousand three hundred and fifty-nine (1359) acres of the John Moore league, Abst. No. 40, formerly owned by J. O. Toole, was assessed to unknown owners at a valuation of \$10.00 per acre, and that the land was rendered by the said J. O. Toole, for the year 1919, and taxes paid on same at a valuation of \$4.00 per acre; that the land is cut-over land and the present owner is willing to pay the taxes on said land at a valuation of \$5.00 per acre, and suggesting that the court reduce the valuation thereon to \$5.00 per acre for 1920, and that an order to such effect be entered in the minutes of this court.

The following Order was entered:

"It is ordered by the commissioner's court of Sabine County, Texas, that said 1359 acres of the John Moore league abstract 40, assessed to unknown owners for the year 1920, be reduced in valuation to the sum of \$5.00 per acre, which is a just and reasonable valuation, and that

A. G. Pratt, Tax Collector, is hereby ordered and authorized to receive the taxes due against

said 1359 acres of the said John Moore league, Abst. 40, at the valuation of \$5.00 per acre, and that the clerk of this court furnish said Tax Collector with two certified copies of this order:

TO THE HONORABLE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF SABINE COUNTY:

It appears from the Tax rolls of Sabine County, that for the year 1920, 1359 acres of the John Moore league, Abst. 40, formerly owned by J. O. Toole, was assessed to unknown owners at a valuation of \$10.00 per acre. This land was rendered by J. O. Toole, for the year 1919 and taxes paid on same at a valuation of \$4.00 per acre. The land is cut over land and the present owner is willing to pay the delinquent taxes on such land at a valuation of \$5.00 per acre, and I suggest that the court reduce the values thereon to \$5.00 per acre for the year 1920, and that an order of such effect be entered in the minutes of such court.
