

The Commissioners' court in and for Sabine County, met in Regular Session December 14th, 1936 with the following members presents, to-wit: Edw. Harper, County Judge, T. R. Smith, Commissioner, Prec. No. 1, E. C. Smith, Commr. Prec. No. 2, P. H. McGown, Commr. Prec. No. 3, R. W. Chapman, Commr. Prec. No. 4, Geo. W. Russell, sheriff, and Zeda Davidson, Clerk, and transacted business as follows:

Accounts were allowed and approved as is shown by Minutes of the Accounts Allowed.

On motion made by P. H. McGown, seconded by R. W. Chapman, it is ordered by the court that the Quarterly report of Financial Statement of Ledger, be and is hereby in all things approved.

On motion by P. H. McGown, seconded by E. C. Smith, with a vote unanimous, in favor of said motion, it is ordered by the court that Mrs. Alice Low, be and she is hereby appointed Tax Assessor and Collector of Sabine County, for the term, of office, beginning January 1st, 1937, to fill the vacancy caused by the death of L. Low, deceased.

On motion by E. C. Smith and seconded by P. H. McGown, it is ordered by the court that Lots #1, and #2 in Block # 24, in the town of Hemphill be valued at \$400.00, and the Tax Collector is hereby authorized to accept taxes for the years of 1930, 1931, 1932, 1933, 1934, 1935 and 1936 on the above basis.

On motion made by P. H. McGown, seconded by R. W. Chapman, with a vote unanimous, it is ordered by the court that lands on the D. H. Ford survey, owned by the Martin Thomas heirs,

rendered on the unknown roll for the years 1929, 1930, 1931, 1932, 1933 and 1934 at the valuation of \$10.00 be reduced to the valuation of \$5.00 valuation per acre, and placed on the rendered roll at said value. The Tax Collector of Sabine County is hereby authorized to accept taxes on said estate at \$5.00 per acre for the above named years.

There being no further business, court adjourned.
