

Commissioner's met on January 16, 1937, with all members present, to-wit: O. A. Beauchamp,

A motion by A.L. Harvill, seconded by R. H. Solley that the Treasurers Report, from Oct. 1, 1936, to Dec. 31, 1936 was approved by unanimous vote.

A \$5000.00 Bond for the District Clerk, Charlie Gooch, was approved, and the Clerk was ordered to release the former \$4000.00 bond.

Be it ordered that the County Judge, do the buying for the Officers, and Court House such as; Stationery, books and general supplies, such as he deems necessary.

It is ordered by the Court that the Taxes charged to V. L. Pitman, for the year 1931, 1933, 1934 and 1936, be calculated on the basis of \$4.00 per acre value. The order is contingent upon the payment of these taxes within 30 days from date. This order is intended to correct the error due to Assessment covering 71 acres when in actuality there is only fifty eight (58) acres in the tract.

← It is the will of The Commissioner's Court that Sabine County continue on a fee basis as heretofore and not avail itself of the option of conforming to the Salary Bill as passed by the 44th Legislature and upon motion of Drayton Speights, seconded by A. L. Harvill, it was ordered that the Officers of Sabine County, Texas, shall for the year of 1937, be compensated by such fees as the law allows and in addition thereto the following yearly salaries are hereby allowed to be paid in monthly installments, as follows:

County Clerk	\$900.00
District "	900.00
County Attorney	600.00
Sheriff	1000.00
Sheriff, Deputy	900.00
County Agent	1000.00

In accordance with H. B. 408, Section 2, 44th Legislature, it is hereby ordered that each Commissioner's salary be \$900.00 payable monthly and shall be paid wholly out of R. & B. Funds other than that impounded by Federal Court Judgment and that the County Judge

shall receive \$150.00 per month, 75% per cent of which shall be paid from same source as Commissioner's Salaries and the remainder from same source as other County Officers. The County Treasurer shall receive as Salary a commission of 2 1/2% of all monies paid into the Treasury and the same per cent on all monies paid out of the Treasury until his compensation shall reach \$2000.00. All fees and commissions due the Treasurer shall be paid unto the fund from which Officers' Salaries are drawn except the \$2000.00 here specifically exempted. The Tax Assessor Collector shall receive such fees and commissions as the law allows him, and it is specifically ordered by the Court that the current collections for the General County Fund be deposited as heretofore ordered by Pre-siding Commissioner's Court and shall be used to pay Current Salaries of County Officers where salaries are ordered to be paid out of General Fund. And the sum total of current collections for the General Fund is hereby appropriated to pay current Salaries from said Fund. And it is ordered by the Court that all receipts from Car Registration be deposited as heretofore in Road & Bridge Special Fund and that the following amounts are specifically appropriated and shall be held in said Fund for that purpose;

And all the remainder of said Fund shall be distributed to Commissioner's Precinct Accounts as heretofore.

On motion by A. L. Harvill, seconded by Drayton Speights, passed by Court, Order as follows: That County Depository is authorized to pay compromise proposal of \$2445.35 made by Distributors Investment Co., Plaintiff in Cause No. 6036, in which Sabine County is Defendant, and in which Judgment was rendered in favor of Plaintiff against said Sabine County. It is further ordered by the Court that above proposal be satisfied out of balance current R & B Special Fund Class, and by warrant in the amount of \$1907.00, to be issued to said depository when said Judgment has been vacated. It is further ordered by the Court, the payment of \$1907.00 be applied to the amount of \$1385.23, to the amount said R & B Special Fund now owes First National Bank by order of late Commissioner's Court and the remainder of said amount, \$521.77 be applied to the payment of Judgment and that the Bank is hereby authorized to advance \$1923.58, the additional amount necessary to retire the Judgment, and it is hereby ordered by the Court that script for \$1923.58, against the Special R & B Fund be issued and delivered to First National Bank and said script shall be a preferred charge against said Fund and shall be paid from Automobile Registration Fees for 1937. This order shall be final upon action of District Judge in vacating Judgment. The above order was unanimously approved by Court.

This being all the business Court adjourned,
