in and for Sabine County, Texas, Commissioners Court met January 25, 1937, with all members present, to-wit:

proved by the Court:

Be it ordered by the Court that scrip for all officers salaries for January 1937, be issued in amounts and paid from funds as ordered by this Court in the first meeting in January, 1937. The Janitors Salary shall be paid from same fund as heretofore and is ordered to be paid when other officers salaries are paid.

On motion, R. H. Solley, seconded by Drayton Speights, it is ordered by the Court that Jury Scrip Reg. #582, date registered 5-21-36, amount \$3.00, and Reg. #479, date Reg. - 5-7-36 amount \$9.00 and payable to J. H. Ener, be cancelled and the the Clerk is authorized to issue duplicates. The reason for this action is, that above described scrip has been lost and it is necessary to issue dephicate to prevent loss to owner.

On motion, G. B. Carter, seconded by A. L. Harvill, it is ordered by the Court, that the plan of referring to Adjustment Matter to the Federal Farm Debt Adjustment Committee: be approved, except that the Court reserves the right to reject any or all the proposals submitted to the Court where any scale down in the amount of indebtedness is recommended. The Court also reserves the right to refuse to enter into or be a party to any agreed. judgments except where there is to be a full settlement of the State and County taxes for years, affected.

Be it ordered by the Court, that General County Scrip Reg. #170 drawn on General County "A" Fund in the amount of \$57.80 be paid by the treasurer. The Treasurer shall issue his check for \$50.00 in full payment of the above scrip. This order is made because there has been no demand for payment on this fund in two years and because this order affects a saving of \$7.80 for the fund.

There being no further business Court adjourned.
