

Commissioner's Court in and for Sabine County, Texas, met on February 8, 1937, with all members present, to-wit: O. A. Beauchamp, County Judge, D. B. Speights, Commr. Prect. #1, R. H. Solley, Commr. Prect. #2, G. B. Carter, Commr. Prect. #3, A. L. Harvill, Prect. #4, C. W. Russell, Sheriff, and J. O. Wright, Clerk.

On motion duly had and carried the bond of L. J. Smith, for Justice of the peace, at Milan, was approved.

On motion duly had and carried R. O. Mott, was appointed Justice of The Peace at Brookeland, and his bond for same was approved.

The Bond of G. D. Jessup, Jr., for \$2,000.00, as Delinquent Tax Collector, was approved.

Be it ordered by the Court that Henry Hogan be, and he is hereby appointed road overseer on road from Hemphill to Sabinetown, through Sunshine Valley to Pologoch.

It was ordered by the court that the following reports be, and they are hereby approved as follows; January report, by Charlie Gooch, District Cler, Russell Watson, Justice of the Peace, report for January, J. C. Speights, Justice of the Peace, Jan. report, R. H. Dent County Attorney, January report, \$3.00 trial fees allowed, Report of W. M. Honeycutt, County Treasurer, report for January, J. O. Wright, County Clerk, Jan. Report.

Accounts were allowed and approved as are shown by the Minuted of Accounts, Allowed.

Be it ordered by the Court that scrip due Clarke and Courts in 1936, be issued in amounts not exceeding \$100.00 at the time.

Be it ordered by the Court that scrip issued to A. J. Howard #645 be cancelled and reissued in two pieces, one for \$14.56 and one for \$1.44.

Be it ordered by the Court that scrip issued to D. E. Willis #782 be cancelled and reissued in two pieces one for \$4.16 and one for \$1.44.

Be it ordered by the Court that the County Clerk issue scrip on the R & B Special Fund in such amounts and in such denominations as are necessary to provide the necessary supplies, including gasoline for each of the four commissioners' Precincts, also for the retirement of script now outstanding, with the specific proviso that not more than \$30,000.00 be so issued including that now outstanding and registered against the Special R & B Fund.

Be it ordered by the Court that the "Unallocated Cash and Securities Fund" be set up and the cash and securities coming into the hands of the County by means of purchase or any manner other than normal retirement procedure be and are the property of said fund. The Treasurer shall keep a six column book, which shall be procured for him which shall show receipts and disbursements and balance at all time in cash and also in securities. The securities owned by said fund may be sold and securities may be purchased for said fund whenever cash is available provided however that no securities shall be purchased or accepted other than County, or county sub-division obligation, and then only in case the purchase price is a saving to the County or Sub-division.

This Fund is set up in an effort to provide a method to allow Sabine County to avail itself of some of the generous discounts being offered by creditors to obtain a settlement.

The County Judge and County Treasurer shall administer the affairs of this fund subject always, however, to the approval of The Commissioners Court and a report shall be made and the books of the Treasurer exhibited to the Court at each regular meeting of the same.

Be it ordered that the Tax Collector deposit in the Unallocated Cash and Securities Fund 10% (per cent) of all delinquent taxes collected for Hemphill Independent School District #4 as per order from the Board of Trustees now on file with the Tax Collector.

There being no further business Court adjourned.
