Commissioner's Court intended for Sabine County/met on February 22, 1937, with the following members present, to-wit: O. A. Beauchamp Judge, D. B. Speights, Com. Pre. #1, R. H. Solley, Commr. Prect. #2, G. B. Carter, Commr. Prect. #3, A. L. Harville, Commr. Pre. #4, and J. O. Wright, Clerk, transacting business as follows:

On Motion by D. B. Speights, seconded by G. B. Carter, it was ordered by the Court that script #1114 be cancelled and reissued on General County Emergency Fund.

Accounts were allowed and approved as are shown by minutes of Accounts Allowed.

On motion duly had and carried it was ordered by the Court that the bid of the First National Bank, at San Augustine, Texas, for Depository for the next two two years be accepted.

On motion by D. B. Speights, seconded by G. B. Carter, it is ordered by the Court that Script Reg. #153, drawn on Gen. Co. Current Expense be cancelled and reissued for the same amount on Gen. County Emergency Fund.

The Commissioner's Court canvassed the returns of the Stock Law election at Bronson, held on February 13, 1937, and find that there were 21 votes for the stock law and 36 votes were cast against the stock law.

WHEREAS, it has been brought to the attention of this Court, that the President of the United States has announced plans of the Administration to synchronize soil erosion control works with flood control programs; and

WHEREAS, it is the announced policy of the Department of Agriculture, "that after July 1, 1937, no new erosion control projects will be established in any state which has not adopted legislation along the lines of the Standard State Soil Conservation Law";

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that this Court, believing that any legislation enacted by the State Legislature should be in accord with the announced policy of the Department of Agriculture and thus result in securing the cooperation of that agency for the people of the State of Texas, hereby appeals to and solicits the aid and cooperation of all citizens of this county, and the Representatives of this county and of the Senator of this district,

towards the early enactment of such conservation laws.

AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be immediately forwarded by the Clerk of this Court to the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Speaker of the House of Representatives and Senators representing this county.

On Motion by D. B. Speights, Seconded by A. L. Harvill, it is ordered by the Court that the Clerk issue Salary Warrants for the County Officers provided for in the Courts order in the first meeting in January, EXCEPT that no officer shall be paid who has not qualified by taking the Constitutional Oath.

There being no further business Court Adjourned.
