

The Commissioner's Court, in and for Sabine County, Texas, met on March 8, 1937, with the following members present: O. A. Beauchamp, County Judge, D.B. Speights, Commr. Pre. #1, R. H. Solley, Commr. Pre. #2, G. B. Carter, Commr. Pre. #3, A. L. Harvill, Commr. Pre. #4, G. W. Russell, Sheriff, and J. O. Wright, Clerk of the Court, transacting the following business, to-wit:

Be it ordered by the Court that the Bond of A. W. Peyton, for #20,000.00, be and is hereby approved.

Be it ordered by the Court that the Report of Russell O. Watson, Justice Peace of Pre. #8, for the Month of February, be, and is hereby approved.

Be it ordered by the Court that the ^{Supplemental} report of L. E. King, Ex. Co. Atty, ending December 1936, be and is hereby approved.

Accounts were allowed as shown in Minutes of Accounts Allowed.

Be it ordered by the Court that D. A. Sibley, W. H. Davidson and Roy Payne be and are hereby appointed to check the County Treasurers books to determine the compensation due the Estate of Marvin W. Honeycutt, deceased, the late County Treasurer and to report the same to Commissioners Court.

Be it ordered by the Court that A. J. Alford, Constable of Pre. #1, be and is hereby authorized to enforce the registration of Motor vehicles according to the terms of the Motor Vehicle Registration Laws and shall be compensated not to exceed Fifty Dollars per month beginning April 1, 1937, to be paid from Registration fees collected by his efforts, and it is specifically provided that this order may be terminated by the Court at any time without notice.

Whereas it is apparent that money must be had for the defense of a suit in Federal Court at Beaumont, now pending, to wit: No. 540, Stone vs Sabine County, and whereas, it is agreed by and between Sabine County, and R. H. Dent, County, Attorney, that \$300.00 will be accepted as final and total fee and expense by said County Attorney for his full services in defense of said suit, in said Court. It is therefore ordered by the Commissioner's Court that said \$300.00 be paid said R. H. Dent as total Fees and expenses in the defense of said suit and that this amount be paid out of any available fund or funds as designated by County Judge O. A. Beaughamp.
