J. H. Wells was elected County Trustee.

It is ordered by the Court that scrip No. 1756, Reg. No. 753 to L. E. Busby, be
cancelled and two pieces written in lieu thereof, the first for \$1.52 and the second for
\$2.08 on the same fund. Also Script No. 193-Reg. No. 313 issued to Sabine County Reporter
for \$36.15 be cancelled and two pieces issued in lieu thereof, one for \$17.60 and the other
for \$18.55 on the same fund.

It is Ordered by the Court that scrip No. 1593, Reg. No. 2432, payable to
Eugene Davidson amount \$5.00 be cancelled and a duplicate issued therefore drawn on the
General County Fund.

It is ordered by the Court that the balance of .46 now in Road District 8, be
transferred to road District 12. The reason for this order is that Road District 8, is
paid out and this order closes the accounts on this issue.

The County Treasurer's Quarterly report was approved.

The Court voted to allow the Sheriff \$50.00 per month automobile expenses as
allowed by Senate concurrent Resolution #40-1935, and Art. 3600 H. C. S. to be paid out of
General County "B" Fund.

The Court voted to allow Mr. A. L. Harvill his salary for April because of
sickness and the fact that his wife is in the hospital causing a due emergency in his
affairs.

The Court voted to allow Mr. A. J. Alford an advance of \$15.00 on his April
Salary.

It is ordered by the Court that Tax Receipt 244 wherein tax is charged for
Road Dist. #3, be corrected. This order is made after investigation and proof shown that
the F. M. Errington Abstract 480 lies outside Rd. District No. 3.

IT APPEARING that on the 9th day of April, 1937, the Teague National Bank presented to Sabine County for payment one Sabine County Road and Bridge Funding Bonds, Series of 1931, in the principal amount of \$1,000, dated July 10, 1931, bearing interest at the rate of 6% per annum, which matured April 10, 1933;

AND IT FURTHER APPEARING that Sabine County does not have on hand in the fund applicable thereto the money with which to pay such bond, principal or interest;

AND IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS, that said County does not claim any time limitation defense against said bond, and does hereby renew its promise to pay said bond together with interest thereon, such payment however to be made ratably and in due proportion to like or similar payments on all other road and bridge bonds and warrants of said county which are properly payable from its Road and Bridge Funds.
