It is ordered that R. & B. script # 866 Reg No. 4032, amount \$12.60 be cancelled and two peices be issued in lieu thereof, one for \$6.60, and the other for \$6.00,

It is ordered that Gen Co script 449, Reg. no. 2962 amount \$100.00 be cancelled and a peice for \$100.00 drawn on the Gen County Fund be issued in lieu thereof.

WHEREAS, after investigation, it was ascertained that the Road & Bridge Special fund of Sabine County will fail to contain sufficient funds to permit operation and continuance of the various functions of County government necessary to be paid from said fund, for the remainder of the calendar year 1937.

Motion was made by Carter and seconded by Harvill, with all commissioners present voting aye on said motion, and it was ordered that for and on behalf of the R & B Special fund the commissioner court of Sabine County, Texas, acting for Sabine County/borrow from the First National Bank of San Augustine, Texas, a sum not to exceed \$2000.00 to be placed in said fund and used from that fund as the law may allow;

And it was further ordered that the first monies, up to the sum of \$2000.00 and interest from date of borrowing, collected by and for this fund in 1938, be set aside and used in repayment of said loan including interest.

It was ordered by the court that Mr. A. J. Alford be released of his duties as special automobile tax enforcement officer, this order to be effective Sept. 15, 1937. And it is further ordered that the unexpended monies held in the R & B Fund to pay this salary be distributed to the Commissioners Accounts.

The reports of the Tax Collector for the year 1936, on to be considered and were in all things approved.

This being all the business, Court adjourned.
