

The Hon. Commissioners' Court, met on Monday, Jan. 10, 1938 with all members present, to-wit:

D. B. Speights, Commissioner Precinct # 1.

Accounts were allowed as shown in Accounts Allowed.

The Bond of Geo. W. Russell, as Sheriff, was approved.

The Bond of Charlie Gooch, as District Clerk, was approved.

It is ordered that Script number 409, Reg. No. 3401 amount 10.67, issued on the R & B Fund be cancelled and a new peice of script for the same amount be issued on the same fund to H. L. Bradshaw, the original payee. This action is taken upon request of County Treasurer, and upon proof that original script is lost.

It is ordered by the Court that the Salary of Henry Gibson, Janitor, be \$35.00 per month for the year 1938, and shall be payable monthly from the same fund as heretofore.

It having been called to the attention of the Court that J. G. O'Keefe, Public Weigher of Prec. # 1, has removed from Sabine County to Harris County and accepted a position, apparently with the intention of staying permanently in Harris County, the Court by a vote of 4 to 0 declared the office of Public Weigher of Prec. # 1, vacant; and upon a vote of 4 to 0 the court appointed J. L. Stewart, to fill the unexpired term of J. G. O'Keefe, as Public Weigher of Prec. # 1. of Sabine County, and his bond is fixed at \$2,500.00.

It is ordered that account allowed Clark & Courts in 1936 for \$1302.69, and which has never been delivered, be issued in twelve \$100.00 warrants and one warrant for \$102.69. It is also ordered that warrant be issued to Clark & Courts for \$67.92, being the amount yet due, them on the 1936 account. It is specifically ordered that the above warrants be issued on and against the General Fund of Sabine County.

The Wyatt Metal & Boiler Works, Dallas, Texas, has made personal application this date for the issuance of several warrants of lesser denominations in lieu of Warrant No. 403, dated November 28, 1932, Register No. 3778 dated November 28, 1932, for \$3803.00, bearing 6% interest per annum.

It is therefore ordered that applicant's petition, in all things, be and is hereby granted to the said Wyatt Metal & Boiler Works, and that said warrants of lesser denominations be, and are hereby allowed in denominations of \$500.00, and in numbers from 1 to 7 inc., and one for \$303.00. The new warrants shall carry the same registration number 3778, as of November 28, 1932.

The New warrants shall read as follows:

"The Treasurer of the County of Sabine, State of Texas:

Pay to the order of Wyatt Metal & Boiler Works, or bearer, the sum of \$500.00 with interest at 3% per annum out of the Road & Bridge Fund, being the amount allowed by the Commissioners' Court of Sabine County, Texas, at its January 10th Term, A. D. 1938, as one of a series of 7 warrants of \$500.00 each and one warrant for \$303.00 issued in lieu of Warrant No. 403."

And it is further ordered that the County Clerk do issue said warrants and deliver same to the Wyatt Metal & Boiler Works, and the County Treasurer is hereby directed to register these new warrants as herei directed.

(It is the will of The Commissioner's Court that Sabine County, continue on a fee basis as heretofore and not avail itself of the option of conforming to the Salary Bill as passed by the 44th Legislature and upon motion of Drayton Speights, seconded by A. L. Harvill, it was ordered that the Officers of Sabine County, Texas, shall for the year of 1938 be compensated by such fees as the law allows and in addition thereto the following yearly salaries are hereby allowed to be paid in monthly installments, as follows:

County Clerk	\$900.00
District Clerk	900.00
County Attorney	600.00
Sheriff	1000.00
Sheriff, Deputy	900.00
County Agent	1000.00

In accordance with H. B. 408, Section 2, 44th Legislature, it is hereby ordered that each Commissioner's salary be \$900.00 payable monthly and shall be paid wholly out of R & B Funds other than that impounded by Federal Court Judgment and that the County Judge shall receive \$150.00 per month, 75% per cent of which shall be paid from same source as Commissioner's Salaries and the remainder from same source as other County officers. The County Treasurer shall receive as Salary a commission of 2 1/2% of all monies paid into the Treasury and the same per cent on all monies paid out of the Treasury until his compensation shall reach \$2000.00. All fees and commissions due the Treasurer shall be paid into the fund from which Officers' Salaries are drawn except the \$2000.00 here specifically exempted. The Tax Assessor Collector shall receive such fees and commissions as the law allows him, and it is specifically ordered by the Court that the current collections for the General County Fund be deposited as heretofore ordered by Presiding Commissioner's Court and shall be used to pay Current Salaries of County Officers where salaries are ordered to be paid out of General Fund. And the sum total of current collections for the General Fund is hereby appropriated to pay current Salaries from said Fund. And it is ordered by the Court that all receipts from Car Registration be deposited as heretofore in Road & Bridge Special Fund and that the following amounts are specifically appropriated and shall be held in said Fund for that purpose:

And all the remainder of said Fund shall be distributed to Commissioner's Precinct Accounts as heretofore.

The report of A. W. Peyton was approved.
 This being all the business, Court adjourned.
