It is ordered by the Court that the above petition be granted and it is hereby ordered that the property of J. M. Roberts and Ben F. Williams being contiguous to the hog law area be added to said area and shall be subject to the laws of said area governing the enforcement of the hog law in said area.

It is the order of the court that the County Treasurer purchase Bond # 28 of Road District no. 12, Bond no. 26, of Road Dist. # 9, and Bond No. 6, of Road District No. 13, for the sinking funds of Road District No. 10, and the Treasurer is Hereby authorized to make such purchase.

Upon request from the board of County and District Road indebtedness, under date of Jan. 22 1938, the County Treasurer is hereby authorized to transfer \$134.62 for the funds of the County Wide Bond Issue to the account of Road District # 2, and it is the positive order of the court that the transfer is meant as a loan only to Road District no. 2, and the Treasurer is hereby authorized to repay the amount of \$134.62, to the County wide Issue as soon as funds accrue in the account of Road District No. 2,. This order is made to permit Road District No. 2, to avail itself of a 50% discount on past due coupons offered by the bond holders for immediate payment.
