It is ordered of the Court that R. H. Dent be allowed \$50.00 for Attorney's Fees for suit pending in Court.

It is ordered by the Court that the Treasurer be authorized, and he is hereby authorized to purchase for Road District No. 10, Three bonds of Road District No. 12, of Five Hundred Dollars, each at a price of 70 and no more.

It is ordered by the Court that County Judge sign with the Highway Department an agreement to maintain the five-tenths miles of Feeder Road to be constructed by the Highway Department from Pineland to Highway No. 8.

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Commissioners' Court of Sabine County, Texas, in regular session on this, the 28 day of Feb. 1938, that the State Highway Department will order a location made on Highway No. "F", from Intersection with Highway No. 8 to Pineland provided Sabine County, through its Commissioners' Court, agrees to secure a minimum of One Hundred (100) foot right-of-way, clear of all obstructions, except standing timber, and furnish without cost to the State, clear title to the necessary right-of-way, including all standing timber, through each and every tract crossed by said highway, and to do the fencing, on location approved by the State Highway Engineer before said location is made.

It is, therefore, ordered that Sabine County, acting herein by and through its Commissioners' Court, agrees and obligates itself to secure a minimum of one hundred (100) foot right-of-way and do the fencing on Highway no. "F", from intersection with Highway No. 8, to Pineland and to clear such right-of-way of all obstructions, except standing timber, and furnish a clear title to each parcel secured, including all standing timber, without cost to the State, through each and every tract crossed by this highway, on location to be approved by the State Highway Engineer.

AGREEMENT BY MUNICIPALITY OR POLITICAL

SUBDIVISION TO MAINTAIN HIGHWAYS IMPROVED

UNDER FEDERAL HIGHWAY ACT
(REGULAR FEDERAL AID PROJECTS)

The County of Sabine, State of Texas hereinafter referred to as the County, and the State Highway Dept. of Texas hereinafter referred to as the Highway Department, hereby agree as follows:

1. That the Highway Department will submit a project for the improvement of 0.5 miles of State Highway No. "Feeder Road" from Intersection with Highway No. 8 to Pineland known as Pineland Spur, and to be designated as Texas FAS 25, and will recommend its approval by the Secretary of Agriculture for construction with funds apportioned to the State under the Federal Highway Act; subject, however, to the condition that the County of Sabine shall provide for its proper maintenance after completion of its improvement.

2. That the said County of Sabine hereby requests the Highway Department to submit the aforementioned project with recommendation that it be approved by the Secretary of Agriculture, and agrees that if such project is approved and constructed by the Highway Department and the Secretary of Agriculture it thereafter, at its own cost and expense, will maintain the project in a manner satisfactory to them, or their authorized representatives, will make ample provision each year for such maintenance.
