TO THE HONORABLE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS:

We, the Undersigned citizens of Sabine County, Texas, being the owners of all the lands within the hereinafter described boundaries respectfully petition your Honorable Body that the territory included within the boundaries of the stock law as now in effect within that certain subdivision of said county as fully set out and described in petition of D. C. Rains, et al. shown on pages 320-321 of the Minutes of the Commissioners Court of said County, which subdivision was attached to and included within the subdivision or District covered by the city limits of the city of Hemphill, the boundaries of the subdivision to which this petition applies and which is asked to be attached to and included within the subdivision mentioned above, being as follows:

Beginning on the south bank of Housen Bayou at the N. E. corner of lands out of the Sion Smith league known as the J. H. Oliphint lands: Thence south with the E. B. line of said Oliphint lands to its S. E. corner on the S. B. line of the Sion Smith league. Thence in a north-westerly direction with the S. B. line of said league to corner of said Oliphint lands in said survey which is the S. E. corner of a 50-acre tract out of said survey purchased by P. P. Beckcom from P. P. Beckcom from Temple Lumber Company. Thence north with the east line of said 50 acres to its N. E. corner. Thence southwesterly and westerly with the S. B. line of said Oliphint tracts to the S. W. corner of same, which is also the S. E. corner of R. K. Beckcom's land. Thence in a northerly direction with the E. B. line of said Beckcom lands to his N. E. corner on Housen Bayou. Thence up Housen Bayou with its meanders to the N. W. corner of R. K. Beckcom's lands. Thence southerly with the W. B. line of said R. K. Beckcom lands to his S. W. corner.

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Thence in a westerly direction with the S. B. lines of the H. W. Carroll 150 acres and W. F. Goodrich 265 acres to W. F. Goodrich S. W. corner in the W. B. line of said Sion Smith league. Thence northeasterly with the W. B. line of the Sion Smith league to Housen Bayou. Thence down Housen Bayou with its meanders to the place of beginning.
