THE STATE OF TEXAS.

To the Sheriff or any Constable of Sabine County, Texas--GREETING:

YOU ARE HEREBY COMMANDED to cause to be posted at the regular voting place in each voting precinct of Sabine County, Texas, for a period of at least six (6) days preceding the 20th day of August, A. D. 1938, a true copy of the following notice:

NOTICE OF LOCAL OPTION ELECTION

"NOTICE is hereby given that an election will be held in each voting precinct in Sabine County, Texas on Saturday the 20th day of August, A. D. 1938, to determine whether the sale of beer that does not contain alcohol in excess of four (4%) per centum by weight, shall be legalized in Sabine County, Texas.

All persons who are legally qualified voters of Sabine County, Texas shall be entitled to vote at said election, and all voters desiring to legalize the sale of beer that does not contain alcohol in excess of four (4%) per cent. by weight shall leave written or printed on their ballots the words:

"FOR legalizing the sale of beer that does not contain alcohol in excess of four (4%) per cent.

by weight."

And those opposed to the legalizing of the sale of beer that does not contain alcohol in excess of four (4%) per cent. by weight, shall leave written or printed on their ballots the words:

"AGAINST legalizing the sale of beer that does not contain alcohol in excess of four (4%) per cent. by weight."

Said election will be held in accordance with and under the provisions of the laws of the State of Texas governing the conduct of general election.
