

Commissioners' Court met in Special Session, on Thursday, August 25, 1938, with the following members present, to-wit:

On this 25th day of August, came on to be considered the application of J. O. Wright, County Clerk to appoint Lera McGown as deputy County Clerk to take acknowledgments; It is therefore ordered by the Court that the appointment of Lera McGown be in all things confirmed.

ORDER DECLARING RESULT OF ELECTION.

On this the 25th day of August, 1938, came on to be considered the returns of an election held on the 20 day of August, 1938, in Common School District No. 14, of this County for the purpose of determining whether or not the school tax, supplementing the State School Fund apportioned to said district, shall be increased to the rate of \$1.00 on the one hundred dollars valuation of taxable property in said District, and to determine whether or not that the Commissioners' Court shall be authorized to levy, assess and collect said tax at said increased rate. It appearing that said election was in all respects legally held and that said returns were duly and legally made and that there were cast at said election 45 valid and legal votes, of which number there were cast:

For the Increase of School tax 27 votes.

Against the Increase of School Tax 18 Votes.

And it appearing to the court from said returns that a majority of the qualified resident property taxpaying voters of said district who owned taxable property in said district and who had duly rendered the same for taxation, voting at said election, voted in favor of said increase of tax, the court does hereby declare the proposition for the said increase of tax to have been adopted, and this court is authorized to levy and have assessed and collected said tax at said increased rate.

ORDER LEGALIZING THE SALE OF 4% BEER

COUNTY OF SABINE #

On this 25th day of August, 1938, came on to be considered the returns of an election held on the 20 day of August, 1938, in Sabine County, Texas, on the issue of "legalizing the sale of beer that does not contain alcohol in excess of four (4%) percentum by weight" in said County and it appearing from said returns, duly and legally made, that there were cast at said election 1701 votes, of which number there were cast:

For legalizing the sale of beer that does not contain alcohol in excess of four (4%) percentum by weight 437 votes.

Against legalizing the sale of beer that does not contain alcohol in excess of four (4%) percentum by weight 1264 votes.

IT IS THEREFORE FOUND AND DECLARED, AND SO ORDERED by the Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas, that a majority of the qualified voters voting at said election voted against "legalizing the sale of beer that does not contain alcohol in excess of four (4%) percentum by weight."
