It is ordered by the Court that the Treasurer transfer \$200.00 from General Emergency Fund to Public Health Fund.

The Treasurer is hereby authorized to purchase two Road District No. 1 bonds \$2000.00. One \$500.00 Road District Nine Bond. \$2500 general funding warrants, a total of \$5000 from the sinking of County Wide Bond Funds and is authorized to pay Four Thousand dollars for the above list of bonds.

It is ordered by the court that the County Clerk issue the salary check heretofore allowed to Mrs. Myrtle Arnold, County Case worker to D. A. Sibley in the same amounts and on the same fund. It is intended that this order shall provide compensation for D. A. Sibley, County Case worker, beginning March 13, 1940, and thereafter on the 13th of each month.

It is ordered that D. C. Nethery be paid \$9.20 from General Emergency fund to compensate him for bus fare for Ira Wright to State Hospital at Sanatorium, Texas.

We the undersigned land owners owning the following described land lying adjacent and contiguous to the Hog Law District, respectfully petition your body to include the following described tracts in the Hog Law District:

Beginning on the East line of the William Clark headright survey, at W. A. Griffin's N.E. corner, thence N. 54 W. to corner. McRae, late of the county of Sabine, 245 vrs. to corner on the S. side of an old road, a red oak 9 ins. in dia. bears N. 71' E. 1-5/10 vrs. dist. Thence N. 40 vrs. to corner stake from which a sugar tree bears N. 69 E. 5 vrs. dist. Thence S. on McRae's line 440 vrs. to his S. E. corner stake from which a magnolia 24 in. dia. bears S. 40 W. 1-5/10 vrs. dist. & a holly 6 in. in dia. bears S. 79 E. 4-5/10 vrs. supposed to be Wm. Clark's League line a white oak 18 in. dia. bears N. 78

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W. 4 vrs. Thence on Clark's line S. 54 E. 375 vrs. to corner on the bank of Pologacho creek a white oak 14 in. in dia. bears N. 12-1/2 E. 3-5/10 vrs. and a beech 16 in. in dia. brs. N. 41 W. 6 vrs. dist. Thence down the Pologacho creek with it's meanders as follows, viz: S. 75 E. 80 vrs. 86-1/2 E. 30 vrs. N. 39-1/2 E. 180 vrs. N. 80 E. 60 vrs. N. 41 E. 60 vrs. N. 86# 190 vrs. N. 30 E. 70 vrs. N. 10-1/2 E. 80 vrs. N. 74 E. 40 vrs. S. 46 E. 10 vrs. S. 88 E. 80 vrs. N. 3 W. 80 vrs. N. 32-1/2 E. 90 vrs. N. 64 E. 130 vrs. N. 77-1/2 E. 30 vrs. to the mouth of Fullen's creek. Thence up Fullen's creek general course N. 37-1/4 W. 605 vrs. to the place of beginning, containing One Hundred Twenty acres of land (120) more or less, bearings marked X.

Beginning at one of Wright Coley's southwest corners on the N. bank of a slough, at a stake from which a beech brs. N. 49 W. 3-2/5 vrs. Thence N. with Coley's W. line 1524 vrs. to a stake on branch, from which a beech 18 ins. brs. S. 86 E. 4 vrs. and a beech N. 63 W. 6 vrs. Thence down said branch east 250 vrs.

Thence S. 54 E. 58 vrs. to James Fullen's N. W. corner on said branch a stake from which a beech 12 ins. brs. N. 1/2 vrs. Thence S. with Fullen's line 960 vrs. to a corner on south side of the road stake from which a red oak 9 ins. brs. N. 71 E. 1-5/10 vrs. Thence W. 40 vrs. stake from which a sugar tree brs. W. 69 E. 5 vrs. Thence south with Burkhalter's line 440 vrs. to Burkhalter's corner stake from which a magnolia 24 ins. brs. S. 40 W. 1-5/10 vrs., and a holly brs. S. 79 E. 4-5/10 vrs. Thence S. 65 W. 300 vrs. with Burkhalter's line to the place of beginning, containing 74 less 25 acres heretofore cut off for Geo. Boyd.
