There came on to be considered the purchase of a tractor for precinct no. 4 and a grader for Precinct No. 2. It is ordered by the court that a 6 cylinder McCormick Deering International Tractor be purchased for Precinct No. 4, and that \$1500 be paid by writing five \$300.00 pieces of Road and Bridge Special Script and charged to precinct No. 4, and that the balance of \$1250.00 be carried as an open account.

It is ordered that an Allis-Chalmers 10 foot grader be purchased for Precinct 2 and that \$600.00 be paid now by writing three \$200.00 pieces of script drawn on R & E Special Fund of Precinct No. 2 and that the balance of \$400.00 be carried as an open account.

There came on to be considered the petition of U. A. Sachtleben and twenty-eight (28) other persons for a stock law election in the vicinity of Pineland. Now, therefore, it is ordered that the petition for election be granted and that the election be held at the regular

voting place in Pineland.

HONORABLE COMMISSIONER'S COURT

SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS

GENTLEMEN:

We the undersigned resident freeholding voters of the following described sub-division of Sabine County, Texas respectfully petition your honorable body to order an election to determine whether or not hogs, sheep and goats shall run at large in the following described areas:

Beginning at a point where the Sabine-San Augustine County Line crosses the south boundary line of the Ben Lindsey league thence southeastwardly with said Ben Lindsey south boundary line to its intersection with the east line of Samuel Nelson Headright; Thence northeastwardly with said Samuel Nelson east boundary line and James McKim east boundary line to intersection with east boundary line of Larkin Groce, thence north with Larkin Groce east boundary line S. E. corner of Martin Whitehead pre-emption abstract No. 230; thence northeastwardly with said Whitehead east boundary line to its intersection with Daniel Estep headright abstract no. 98; thence S. E. with south boundary line of Daniel Estep to his S. E. corner thence northeast with said Estep east boundary line to his N. E. corner, thence northwest with north boundary line of Daniel Estep to his northwest corner same being in the east boundary line of Alfred Estep preemption abstract no. 247, thence northeast with said Alfred Estep east boundary line to his northeast corner; thence northwest with Alfred Estep north boundary line to southwest corner of T & N O section 25 abstract no. 236, thence southwestwardly with south boundary line of said T & N O to his southwest corner thence westwardly with north boundary line of T. J. Martin and Thomas Lindsey to intersection with Sabine-San Augustine county line thence southward with said county line to place of beginning.
