There came on to be considered the allocation of the Lateral Road Fund and it is hereby
ordered that the funds available in said fund be expended as follows:

\$500.00 for Precinct No. 4.
\$500.00 " " 2
\$550.00 " " 3.
\$700.00 " " 1.

And it is the further order that only items eligible to be paid from these funds be paid
with this money and the treasurer is hereby directed to select such eligible items and pay them
for each precinct subject to the limitation given above.

It is also ordered that the two bonds longest past due in Road District No. 4, be paid from
said funds the bonds to be paid to be determined by the Treasurer.

The Tax Assessor presented the 1940 tax roll for approval. It is the order of the Court
that the roll be and it is hereby approved.

There came on to be considered the purchase of gravel bed from Henry Marshburn & wife and
it is the order of the court the purchase be it is hereby consummated. It is the order of the

Court that the payment of \$100.00 specified in deed be made from funds of Road District No. 10.

Q. R. Wilson applied for appointment as Justice of the Peace of Precinct No. 8 at Geneva,
for the unexpired term of 1940, made vacant by resignation of Paul S. Wilson. By unanimous vote
he is hereby appointed Justice of the Peace in Precinct 8, Sabine Co., Texas.
