

THEREFORE, BE IT ANOUN That I, Charlie Force, County Judge of Sabine County, Texas, do hereby order an election to be held on the 28th day of January, A.C. 1941; at the theater building in the said City of Pinelana, Texas, for the following purpose and none other:

"LECTING A MAYON, A CITY MAMIALL AND FIVE SHOEMMAN FOR THE CALL CITY OF FINELAND, TEXAS" By any person who has attained the use of twenty-one years and who has resided within the corporate limits of said dity for six months next preceding the date of said election and is a qualified voter under the laws of the State of Texas, shall be entitled to vote at said election.

No person shall be eligible to any of shid offices unless he possesses the requisites provided for voters at such election.

M.E. Morris is hereby appointed to serve as presiding officer at said election, and he is suthorized and cirected to select two judges and two clerks to assist in holding the same. Ten days' notice of the time and place of holding the said election shall be given by posting notices thereof in three public places in said city and by publication thereof in two weekly issues of a newspaper of general circulation in the county, and the date of the first publication shall be ten full cays prior to the date of said election.
