At this regular meeting of Commissioners' Court on this 14th day of April, 1941, the question of investment for surplus funds of Road District No.10, came up for discussion. After consideration and discussion, it was moved by G.B. Carter and seconded by Drayton Speights and unanimously carried that \$2000.00 of surplus funds on deposit with State Treasurer for Road District No.10, be invested in \$2000.00 Sabine County R & B Funding Bonds Series 1931, Bonds Nos. 12 and 13, bearing interest at 6% and maturing \$1000.00 1943 and \$1000.00 in 1944, at par and the Board of County and District Indebtedness and/or the State Treasurer are hereby requested to make payment for the bonds when presented to them by the First National Bank of San Augustine, Texas, and to hold said bonds for the benefit of said Road District No.10.

It is further ordered that the County Judge and County Treasurer be directed to take whatever steps necessary to carry out this order.
