On motion duly had and carried it is ordered by the Commissioner's Court of Sabine County, that the Sabine-San Augustine Bi-County health unit be reestablished on the same basis as that of 1940.

It is the will of the Court that order passed Jan. 27, 1941, authorising the Clerk of the Court to issue all warrants for salaries and other indebtedness to be paid out of General Co. "B" Fund at a discount of 15% be rescinded and Warrants issued on this Fund are to be written at face value.

It is ordered by the Court that Warrants #8644-#8655-#8645/and #8642 be cancelled and rewritten to include the 15% discount previously deducted from said warrants.

There being no further business, Court Adjourned.
