and unanimously carried, it is ordered that \$2000.00 Sabine County Refunding Warrants dated
4/10/32 now belonging to Road District #5, be traded for \$2000.00 Road District #12, bonds

now belonging to Road District #10; that \$2000.00 Sabine County Refunding Warrants dated 4/10/32 owned by Road District #6 be traded for \$2000.00 Road District #12 bonds owned by County Wide; that \$500.00 R & B Refunding Warrants dated 3/15/39 owned by Road District #12, be traded for \$500.00 Road District #13 bond owned by Road District #10. The Treasurer is hereby ordered to re-allocate the above securities in accordance with this order. It is further ordered that \$4500.00 Road District #12 bonds and \$500.00 Road District #13, bond be traded to First National Bank for \$4100.00 Sabine County permanent Improvement and General County B current warrants.

It is ordered by the Court that the Clerk of the County Court issue all warrants for salaries earned after September 1st 1941, and other indebtedness to be paid out of General County "B" Fund, at a discount of 15 per cent.

There being no further business, Court adjourned.
