The Honorable Commissioners' Court of Sabine County, met at its regular meeting place in Hemphill, Texas, on September 22nd 1941, with the following members present, to-wit:

Commissioner, D.B.Speights made a motion, same being seconded by J.T.Ener, to expend the funds received by the County from the Lateral Road Accounts as follows:

(a) For the acquisition of right-of-way for County lateral roads and for the payment of obligations incurred therefor prior to January 2nd 1939, (b) for the construction or improvements of the County lateral roads, (c) for paying the principal, interest and sinking fund requirements of any bonds or warrants which were legally issued by such county or road district prior to January 2nd 1939, the proceeds of which were actually expended in the construction or improvement of lateral county roads, (d) for the purpose of supplementing funds appropriated by the United States Government for Works Progress Administration Highway Construction, Public Works Administration Highway construction, and such other grants of Federal funds as may be made available to the Counties of this State for County lateral road construction and (e) for the purpose of cooperation with the State Highway Department and Federal Government in the construction of farm to market roads.

This Motion made by Speights and seconded by J.T.Ener, was voted on and carried by a unanimous vote.

On motion by D.B.Speights and seconded by J.T.Ener, the Commissioners' Court of Sabine County voted unanimously to rescind order approving Hog Law Petition passed on by said Court August 25, 1941, due to misunderstanding of the Court as to the boundary lines describing territory in "Petition to Add Adjacent Territory to Existing Hog Law Territory".

There being no further business, Court adjourned.
