

The Honorable Commissioners' Court of Sabine County, Texas, met in Special session on October 29, 1941, with the following members present:

It appearing to the Court, at the suggestion of the Tax Collector, that 12 acres of the Joseph Walker Survey, Abst. No. 57, appears on the delinquent tax rolls assessed to D.A. Sibley for the years 1932, 1933, 1934, 1936, 1937, 1938, 1939 and 1940, and assessed for taxes on a valuation for the year 1932 at \$900.00, for 1933 at \$900.00, for 1934, \$850.00 for 1936, \$850.00, for 1937, \$850.00, for 1938, \$800.00, for 1939, \$700.00 for 1940, at 850, and it further appearing to the Court that such valuation on said property is excessive and unreasonable and that a valuation of \$500.00 upon said property for each of said years is a fair and reasonable valuation thereon.

It is therefore, ordered, that the valuation of the assessment on said property for each of said years above mentioned be and is hereby reduced to \$500.00, and the Tax Collector of Sabine County is hereby authorized to accept payment of taxes due against said property for each of said years upon a valuation of \$500.00, and that the remainder of the taxes charged against said property for said years be credited as an excessive and unreasonable assessment.
