

The Honorable Commissioners' Court of Sabine County, Texas, met in regular session on the 9th day of February, A.D. 1942, with the following members present:

Accounts were allowed as shown by the "Minutes of Accounts Allowed."

On Motion duly had and carried, it is ordered by the Court that the County Treasurer set up a "Sabine County Medical Fund".

It is further ordered by the Court that the County Clerk issue Warrant on General County Fund for \$34.44 to J.W. Minton covering excess taxes paid.

On motion by T.L. Arnold, seconded by D.B. Speights, with a vote unanimous in favor of said Motion, it is ordered by the Court that the following petition be and the same is hereby in all things granted, and the election for such be and is hereby ordered held March 28th 1942. Petition as follows:

"Hemphill, Texas

January 31, 1942

TO THE HONORABLE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS:

We, the undersigned constituting at least twenty free holders of the hereinafter described subdivision or territory of Sabine County, do hereby petition your honorable body to order an election to be held in said Sub-division on some day named by you for the purpose of enabling the free holders of such subdivision to determine whether hogs, sheep or goats shall be permitted to run at large in such subdivision, the boundaries of said sub-division being as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a corner on Tebo Creek being the N.W. corner of the J.F. Clark, et al, 60 acres and the N.E. corner of the J.D. Strickland 76 acres, now owned by J.L. Payne, within the William Clark League; THENCE South with the West line of said Clark 60 acres and the West line of the R.C. Butler tract of land to Butler's S.W. corner being the N.W. corner of the Earnest McLemore home place; THENCE East with the North line of Earnest McLemore's home place to the William Clark East League line; THENCE N. 36 E. with Williams Clark's League line to the N.W. corner of Jack Jordan's 57 acres; THENCE East with Jordan's N. line to his N.E. corner being the N.W. corner of what is known as the Knox 335 acres now owned by Temple Lumber Company; Thence S. 1272 vrs. to the S.W. corner of said 335 acres continuing said course to the Hemphill & Gravel Hill Highway; THENCE South easterly with the Hemphill & Gravel Hill Highway to its Junction with the Hemphill & Bronson Highway; THENCE Westerly with said Hemphill & Bronson State Highway to the West line of the Collins Buckley Survey, being J.J. Huffman's N.W. corner; THENCE S. 15 E. with Buckley's W. line to its S.W. corner; THENCE S. 32 W. 204 vrs. to corner on the N. line of the H.S. White survey; THENCE S. 58 E. 120 vrs. to H.S. White corner; THENCE S. 32 W. 1116 vrs. to H.S. White's S.E. corner on North line of Robt. Smith Survey; THENCE S. 58 E. with Robt. Smith's N. line to the N.W. corner of 40 acres owned by H.D. Allbritton; THENCE S. 32 W. with the west line of H.D. Allbritton and H.C. Pratt and W.C. Arnold and H.H. Byley to corner on Housen Bayou, the S.E. corner of 27 acres owned by Temple Lbr. Company; THENCE up Housen Bayou with its meanderings to the mouth of Watt's creek; THENCE up Watts' creek with its meanders to the West line of a tract of 200 acres owned by Temple Lbr. Company; THENCE N. 7 W. with Temple's West line and Mrs. Pearl Arnold's E. line to the Housen Bayou; THENCE up Housen Bayou to the S.W. corner of 197 acres owned by Mrs. Pearl Arnold; THENCE N. 5 W. with Mrs. Arnold's W. line 687 vrs. to corner on the S. line of 50 acres owned by Mrs. Pearl Arnold; THENCE S. 85 W. with the S. line of said 50 acres 80 vrs. to its S.W. corner; THENCE N. 5 W. 421 vrs. to the S.W. corner of 45 acres known as the John Bennett tract; THENCE N. 85 E. 620 vrs. to the S.E. corner of said Bennett 45 acres; THENCE N. 5 W. 411 vrs. to Bennett's N.E. corner; THENCE S. 85 W. 620 vrs. to Bennett's N.W. corner; THENCE N. 5 W. to the N.E. corner of the A.J. Bennett 193-1/4 acres; THENCE S. 85 W. 653 vrs. to H.L. Jordan's S.W. corner on the E. line of the W.Q. Carlton 100 acres;

THENCE N. 5 W. to the N.E.corner of the Carlton 100 acres; THENCE S. 85 W. 356 vrs. to corner of the Kirby Lumber Corporation 2000 acres; THENCE N. 5 W. 1205 vrs. to the N. line of the John Clark League; THENCE East to the S.E. corner of the R.C.Carlton Home place; THENCE N. 12 E. 440 vrs. to Carlton's N.E.corner; THENCE S.85 W. with Carlton's N. line and Herrington's N. line to corner on the W. line of the Wm. Clark League; THENCE N. 11 E. with Wm. Clark's W. line 1798 vrs. to Tebo Creek; THENCE down Tebo Creek with its meanders to the place of beginning.
