On motion by D. B. Speights, seconded by J. T. Ener it is hereby ordered that the Delinquent Tax Report for 1928 to 1940 be and it is hereby approved.

Among other business, Mr. M. L. Daniels, Dallas, Texas, was heard concerning the pasticue interest, and the Judgment taken against Sabine County Road District Mo. 7 in Cause Mo. 6215 in the District Court of Sabine County.

The interest claims are as follows on the March 1, 1923 issue:

It was further found that the Sinking Fund of Road District No. 7 Bonds dated April 1, 1941, lacked \$50.00 of having sufficient funds of meeting the April, 1942 interest requirement.

Mr. Daniels proposed that he would deliver all evidences representing the above described delinquent interest, and would assign to Sabine County, or cause to be canceled, the above Judgment upon payment to him of \$1900.00. After he had explained that by the cancellation of the above items, the General Fund Obligation to Road District No. 7 Bonds dated 3-1-23 could be relieved of its interest obligation in the amount in excess of \$1080.00, it was deemed by the Court to be to the best interest of the County to accept Mr. Daniel's proposition Upon motion made it was unanimously carried.

Mr. K. W. Peyton, County Treasurer, is hereby instructed to make such transfers as to make County Wide Funds available in the amount of \$1950.00 to accept this offer, out of high \$50.00 will be used in payment of the Coupon due April 1, 1942 on the issue of Bonds dated April 1, 1941, and upon delivery of the judgment assignment, the Bonds covered by the Judgment, and all outstanding and unpaid coupons of the March 1, 1923 issue of bonds to pay to M. L. Daniels \$1900.00.

There being no further business Court adjourned.
