On Motion by Commissioner J. T. Ener and seconded by Commissioner D. B. Speights it is ordered by the Court that:

WHEREAS, the declining revenue from the gasoline tax received by the State of Texas for the payment of interest and principal maturities on the bonds issued by the several counties of the State, which are now participating in such revenue, will greatly reduce the available funds the Board of County and District Road Indebtedness will have available during 1943 for the payment of the State's portion of the principal maturities after the payment of interest;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Sabine County refund all of the State's portion of principal maturing during the year 1943, or such portion that the Board of County and District Road Indebtedness deems expedient;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by this court that the County Clerk furnish the Board of County and District Road Indebtedness at Austin, Texas, with a certified copy of this Order.
