It is ordered by the Court that the public road leaving highway #96 at Jack Amason's house and running West toward Bear Creek to fork of road leading from Jim Mills Store to Bear Creek be designated as the County Public Road.

The Resignation of Frank Rash as Deputy Constable of Prec. #1, is hereby accepted by the Court.

On Motion by G. B. Carter and Seconded by T. L. Arnold, it is ordered by the Court that Bond #71, for \$1000, Sabine Co. County Refunding Bond be purchased for Sinking Fund for County Wide out of County Wide funds and the County Treasurer is hereby directed to pay for same.

After due notice had been given, and bids received, it is ordered by the Court that the First National Bank of San Augustine, be accepted as County Depository for the years 1943 and 1944, and the Bonds covering School Funds and County Funds are herewith approved.

It is ordered by the Court that R. S. McDaniel be and he is hereby appointed Justice of the Peace for Prec. #7, Sabine County.
