It is ordered by the Court that Script #9911 on General County Funds payable to Crawford Austin Mfg. Co. for \$238.20 be cancelled by the Clerk and Script issued in lieu of same as follows: Nine pieces for \$25.00 each and one piece for \$13.20.

The Quarterly Report of the County Treasurer was approved by the Court.
