ORDER DECLARING RESULT OF ELECTION

On this the 13th day of Sept. 1943, came on to be considered the returns of an election held on the 2nd day of Sept. 1943, for the purpose of determining whether or not a majority of the qualified voters of Black Jack Common School District #30, Sabine County, Texas, desires to consolidate with Brookeland Independent School Dist. #3, Jasper County, Texas.

It appearing that said election was in all respect legally held, that said returns were duly and legally made and that the said returns show that a majority of the votes cast in said election favored the consolidation; The Court hereby declare the proposition for the consolidation of the said District.
