It is ordered by the Court that the Sheriff's Salary be raised in the amount of \$37.50 instead of the Court employing a deputy sheriff.

On motion by G. B. Carter and Seconded by T. L. Arnold, and by a unanimous vote of the Court, it is ordered by the Court that the County purchase four \$1000.00 Funding Warrants being No. 41, 42, 43 and 44, this to be purchased for County Wide Sinking Fund for \$4,000.00. Also the Court accepts 88 coupons at \$30.00 each aggregating \$2,640.00, also \$1,096.31 of General County "B" Script without cost to the County.
