Hamilton, it was ordered that the County Purchase for Road District #10, Sabine County Road District #13 Bond being Bond No. 6, for \$500.00 and Road and Bridge #1 Funding Warrant #26, 1928 issue in the amount of \$1000.00 and the cancellation of \$211.53 free to the County, General County B Script, and it was also ordered to trade Sabine County Road and Bridge Refunding 1939 issue Warrants #8 and #9, \$500.00 each owned by Road District 10, for Road and Bridge Refunding, 1928 issue, Bond #27, in the amount of \$1000.00.
