

The Honorable Commissioners' Court of Sabine County met at the regular meeting place in Hemphill, Texas, on March 27, 1944, with the following members present, to-wit:

Accounts were allowed as are shown by the Minutes of "Accounts Allowed".

The following petition was presented to the Court:

TO THE HONORABLE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS.

We, the undersigned persons, constituting a majority of the owners of the hereinafter described lands, which adjoin lands over which a stock law now prevails and in which hogs, sheep and goats are not permitted to run at large, hereby petition your honorable body to include the following lands in said stock law territory, and that you pass an order extending the stock law forbidding the running at large of hogs, sheep and goats to include such land, said lands requested to be included in said stock law being described by metes and bounds as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on the West line of the J. S. Chivaler Survey, Abstract No. 186 at the S. W. corner of the G. O. Nether 150 acre tract from which a Post Oak 6" hrs N. 84 E. 3.5 yrs. a pine 9" hrs. S. 3 E. 6.4 yrs.

THENCE S. 1/2 E. with the West boundary line of said Chiveral Survey 608 vrs. to its S. W. corner, being the N. W. corner of the Pinkney Oliphint Survey, a U. S. concrete post marked S-529;

THENCE E. to the North line of said Pinkney Oliphint Survey at 937 vrs. stake for corner being the northeast corner of said Oliphint Survey and one of the Northwest corners of Willie Halbert's land;

THENCE South with Chiverals League line 601 vrs. to a corner in an old road;

THENCE with said road S. 78 E. 52 vrs. S. 73 1/2 E. 105 vrs. S. 80-3/4 E. 71 vrs. S. 69 E. 61 vrs. to a corner at the Moses Hill League West line;

THENCE North with said League line 80 vrs. to the N. W. corner of the Hill League;

Thence East 436 vrs. to the S. E. corner of Willie Halbert land and the Wouthwest corner of the Kirby Lumber Company 149 acres on the North line of the Moses Hill League;

THENCE N. 727 vrs. to stake for corner; THENCE E. 704 vrs. to another Southeast corner of Willie Halbert's land; THENCE N. 704 vrs. to the N. E. corner of a 54 acre tract owned by the U. S. Forest Service; THENCE West 990 vrs. to the N. W. corner of said Forrest Service tract; Thence S. 213 vrs. to stake for corner being the N. E. corner of the G. O. Netherly 149 acre tract on the West line of said Forrest Service 54 acres, stake for corner in mound of rocks on the North side of a branch, white oak 15" and sweetbay 15" for witness trees; THENCE West at 242 vrs. past the S. E. corner of the G. O. Netherly 150 acre tract and at 1387 vrs. reached the place of beginning.
