

The Honorable Commissioner's Court of Sabine County met at the regular meeting place in Hemphill on September 25, 1944, with the following members present, to-wit: Chas. Forse, County Judge, H. J. Hamilton, Commissioner Precinct 1, Everett Smith, Commr. Prec. 2, and T. L. Arnold, Commissioner Prec. 4.

Mrs. G. B. Carter named and appointed by Chas. Forse, County Judge, to fill unexpired term of G. B. Carter, Decd. effective Sept. 25, 1944, until Jan. 1, 1945. The Bond of Mrs. G. B. Carter approved by the Court.

Accounts were allowed as are shown by the "Minutes of Accounts Allowed".

Oscar P. Pate was unanimously appointed by the Court to serve as Service Officer for Sabine County. This appointment was made under the provisions of H. B. 368, 48th Legislature.

It is the order of the Court that 4, warrants for \$875.00 each be issued on R. & B. Special Fund, on Precinct #2, due the 1st day of May, 1945 and one due on the 1st day of May each year thereafter with 5% interest from date in payment of Grader. These warrants are to be made payable to Paul Bleakley.

There being no further business, court adjourned.
