Todd's store, and included all the public Roads within the sforesaid boundaries. AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That he have the following named hands to work said road, to-wit: Wexie Cook, James J. Canton, R. D. Canton, Jr., Q.T. C. Canton, Seers Dennis, Rocky Ray Dennis, Paul Cook, Claude A. Cook, Rodney R. Roberts

With authority to summon any and all other persons, not designated herein, and known to him to be liable to work on the Public Roads within said precinct.
