

The Honorable Commissioner's Court of Sabine County met at the regular meeting place in Sabine County, at Hemphill,  
On February 12, 1945,

with the following members present, to-wit: Chas. Forse, County Judge, H. J. Hamilton, Commissioner of Precinct  
#1, Everett Smith, Commissioner Precinct #2, B. E. Marshburn, Commissioner Precinct #3, and T. L. Arnold,  
Commissioner Precinct #4.

Accounts were allowed as are shown on the Minutes of Accounts allowed.

It is ordered by the Court by unanimous vote that the money received by the County for Federal Forest Money  
be divided between the Road Precincts of the County in the following proportions; 29% goes to Prec. #2, 29%  
goes to Precinct #4, 21% goes to Precinct #1 and 21% to Prec. #3.

It is ordered by the Commissioner's Court that the County Attorney's salary be raised from \$50.00 per month  
to \$75.00 per month beginning with the Feb. 1945, salary check.

It is unanimously voted by the Court that the First National Bank, San Augustine continue as County Depository  
for 1945 and 1946.

There being no further business, court adjourned.
