The Honorable Commissioner's Court of Sabine County met at the regular meeting place in Sabine County, Texis, on August 13, 1945, with the following members present, to-wit: Ghas, Forse, County Judge, H. J. Hamilton, Commissioner Precinct #1, Everett Smith, Commissioner Precinct #2, B. E. Marshburn, Commissioner Frecinct #3, and T. L. Arnold, Commissioner Precinct #4. Accounts were allowed as are snown by the "Minutes of Accounts Allowed". On motion by T. L. Arnold, and seconded by Everett Smith it is ordered by the Court that the valuation of the 12 acres of land North of L. H. & G. Railroad in North end of Hemphill owned by Burton Halbert be fixed by the Tax Collector at \$150.00 per years for past years back to 1936. On Motion duly had and carried it is ordered by the Court that the County Clerk issue a duplicate check to Crawford-Austin Mfg. Co. in lieu of check #9911 for \$238.20, Register No. 6072; that had been issued for supplies, but, according 'to affidavit presented to the Court made by R: B. Goddard, Vice President of the Grawford-Austin Mfg. Co.was lost before being presented to the Bank for payment.

On motion by T. L. Arnold, seconded by Everett Smith, it is unanimously carried by the court that all precinct lines be reestailished throughout the County and that when this has been done that 7 maps showing these new lines and other information be purchased by the County for the County.

Upon application duly presented, it is ordered by the Court that Mrs. Myrtle Arnold, Co. Clerk, of Sabine County, Texas, be and she is nereby authorized to appoint and deputize Grace Anne Frazer as Deputy Co. Clerk in said office. Said appointment to date from the 14th day of August, 1945, and to continue in effect until revoked by said officer or be otherwiseto terminated; and the compensation/be paid said deputy is hereby fixed on commission basis, per annum, payable solely from the fees of said office.

There being no further business, Court Adjourned.
