IT FURTHER APPEARS and the Commissioners' Court affirmatively so finds that in order to prevent and relieve default and impending default and impending default in the payment of principal and interest of the hereinbefore described warrants, it is necessary that they be refunded and be made to mature with a more convenient schedule of maturities, as hereinafter more fully set out, and that accordingly this Court has lawful authority to refund this indebtedness without the publication of notice or the right to referendum thereon, as provided in the latter part of Section 7 of the Bond and Warranty Law of 1931, and this Court hereby invokes the authority so to do, as provided in the above mentioned statute.

And to pay the interest on said warrants and to create a sinking fund with which to pay the principal at maturity, such tax of and at the rate of 3 cents, on each one hundred dollars' valuation of taxable property in said County is hereby levied for the year 1945, and the same or so much thereof as may be necessary, and so much more as may be necessary, is hereby levied for each succeeding year while said warrants or any of them are outstanding;

And there shall be calculated each year while any of said warrants are outstanding and unpaid what rate of tax is necessary to provide current interest and the required amount of the principal for such year, or proportionate part thereof, and a tax at such rate on each one hundred dollars' valuation of taxable property in said county within the limits permitted by the Constitution and Laws of Texas, shall be levied, assessed and collected during each of said years, and said tax of and at the rate so found to be necessary for each of such years is hereby levied, and is ordered to be levied, assessed and collected.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Chas. Forse, County Judge, County Judge of Sabine County, be and he is hereby authorized and directed to take and have charge of said Refunding Warrants, and he shall have authority to deliver said refunding Warrants, to the holders of the hereinbefore described warrants, when the original warrants herein listed have been surrendered to him and cancelled.
