Order Authorizing appointment of Deputy

In Commissioner's Court of Sabine County, Texas.

Upon Application duly presented, it is ordereddby the Court that H. E. Solly/of Sabine County, Texas, be and he is hereby authorized to appoint and deputize Carroll Wright as Deputy Sheriff in said office. Said appointment to date from the 21 day of Jan. 1945, and to continue in effect until revoked by said officer or be otherwise terminated; and the compensation to be paid said deputy is hereby fixed at the sum of One Hundred & Twenty Five Dollars, per month.

Be it ordered by the Commissioner's Court that the Sheriff be allowed .75¢ per day for feeding prisoners instead of the 50¢ now paid.

Upon motion duly had and carried it is ordered that \$8.33 be added to the County Agents Salary per month instead of the \$8.00 paid to his helper.
