Hog Law Petition

TO THE HONORABLE COMMISSIONER'S COURT OF SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS:

We, the undersigned persons, constituting a majority of the resident free holders of the hereinafter described lands, which adjoin lands over which a stick law now prevails and in which hogs, sheep and goats are not permitted to run at large, hereby petition your Honorable body to include the following lands in said stock law territory, and that you pass an order extending the stock law forbidding the running of hogs, sheep and goats at large to include such lands, the lands required to be included in said stock law, being described by metes and bounds as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on Housan Bayou at the S. W. corner of the H. H. Byley 27 acres; thence N. 33 E. with the W. line of said 27 acres to its N. W. corner; thence S. 57 E. to the N. E. corner of said 27 acres; thence N. 33 E. with the west line of the H. H. Byley, H. C. Pratt and John Kirbo tracts to corner in the N. line of the R. H. Smith Survey; thence N. 57 W. with Smith's North line to corner on the east line of the John Clark League; thence S. 5 E. with John Clark's East line to the Housan Bayou; thence up Housan Bayou to the mouth of Watts Creek; thence up Watts Creek with its meanders to the west line of the Kirby Lumber Corporation 500 acres on the east line of the John Gilbert League; thence S. 5 E. with Gilbert's East line to Gilbert's S. E. corner on the north line of the Martha Davidson Survey; thence S. 85 W. with Gilbert's South line to the N. E. corner of the J. H. Lamberth Survey; Thence S. 5 E. with Lamberth's East line to its S. E. corner; thence S. 85 W. to the N. E. corner of the Ed Meyer Survey; thence S. 5 E. with Ed Meyers east line to corner on the northwest line of the John Moore League, Abstract No. 41; thence N. 35 E. with John Moore's line to its north corner; thence S. 55 E. with Moore's Northeast line to the Southeast corner of the John Saddler Survey, Abstract No. 300; Thence N. 35 E. with Saddler's east line to its northeast corner; thence S. 58 E. to corner on the west line of the Susan McLeod Survey; thence N. 32 E. with McLeod's west line to the S. W. cor. of the Cad Davis Labor; thence S. 58 E. with David's South line to its S. E. cor. on the west line of the John L. Quinalty survey; thence N. 32 E. with Quinalty's west line to its N. W. corner on the south line of the Sion Smith League; thence S. 58 E. with Smith's South line to the S. E. cor. of a 50 acre tract purchased by P. P. Beckcom from Temple Lumber Company; thence N. 35 E. and N. 24 E. with the east line of said 50 acres to its most Northeasterly corner; thence S. 76 W. to the N. W. corner of said 50 acres; Thence N. 58 W. with the N. line of another 50 acre tract and 36 acre tract and the North line of the C. C. and C. A. Easley 113 acres and N. 65 W. with the North line of the C. C. and C. A. Easley 58 acre tract to the N W corner of said 58 acre tract on the south line of the P. S. Goen 150 acre tract; thence N. 32 W. to the N. E. corner of what was once known as the Miller 100 acres at the S. E. corner of the W. F. Goodrich 250 acre farm; thence N. 58 W. to the Southwest corner of said Goodrich 250 acres; thence N. 32 E. with Sion Smith's west line to the Housan Bayou, thence up said Bayou with its meanders to the place of beginning.
