WE, the following named persons, qualified voters of the State of Texas, County of Sabine, in Justice Precinct #1, petition your honorable court to order an election to be held in said Precinct to determine whether or not the sale of vinous and malt liquors that do not contain alcohol in excess of 4% by weight shall be legalized in this Precinct and to determine whether or not vinous and malt liquors that do not contain alcohol in excess of 14% by Volume may be sold in said Precinct legally.
