

The Honorable Commissioner's Court of Sabine County met on Wednesday Morning, March 12, 1947 in special session in cooperation with Jasper and Newton Counties to help stamp out Habid Fox in Sabine County with the

The following orders were passed. On motion of E.C. Smith and seconded by G.B. Conn and unanimously carried it

was ordered by the Commissioners' Court that all dogs within Sabine County be vaccinated within 30 days from

date and that all dogs must carry a vaccination tag.

It is further ordered by the Court that after 30 day afrom this date all dogs not wearing tags should

be reported to the Sheriff's Department who will investigate same.

And it is further ordered by the Court that a \$2.00 Bounty be paid by Sabine County for six inches of

each Fox Tail delivered to the County Judge of Sabine County and that after Saturday, March 15 they will not

pay \$1.00 for each right front foot as heretofore done.
