

The Honorable Commissioner's Court met in regular session in the regular meeting place on Monday, April 14, A.D. 1947, with the following members present to-wit: Chas. Forse, County Judge; G.B. Conn, Commissioner Precinct No. 1; E.C. Smith, Commissioner precinct No. 2; J. R. Thomas, Commissioner Precinct No. 3; H.J. Vickers, Commissioner Precinct No. 4.

On contending by the County School Superintendent, H. E. King, the Commissioner's Court voted unanimously to give the Schools of Sabine County 50% of the Forestry Money received from the Federal Forestry Department to be divided among the various school districts according to their acreage taken up by the National Forest.

On motion by H. J. Vickers and seconded by J. R. Thomas it was agreed by the Court that the Extension Service be continued in Sabine County until June 30, 1947. The salary paid the new County Agent, Mr. Nix, is to be the same as that paid to Mr. H. C. Hutson.
