

The Honorable Commissioner's Court Met in Special Session in the regular meeting place on Monday, June 26, 1947, with the following members present to-wit: Chas. Forse, Co. Judge, G. B. Conn, Comm. Prec. #1; E. C. Smith, Comm. Prec. #2; J. R. Thomas, Comm. Prec. #3; H. J. Vickers, Comm. Prec. #4.

WHEREAS the exploratory cooperative Malaria Control program that has been conducted in the fourth quarter of this fiscal year 1947, on a fee basis, has become very popular, produced good results, and was also found to be financially sound, and WHEREAS, in compliance with popular demand and public health needs, this program should be continued.

THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Commissioners Court, this day in session, ^{on} go/record agreeing to the continuation of the program on the same basis for the next quarter, (July 1 to September 30, 1947,) and be it further resolved that for the last quarter of the fiscal year 1948, (April 1 to June 20), the local participation be increased so as to include not only the furnishing of labor, but also an allocation of \$50.00 per month, per spray crew employed. This additional \$50.00 per spray crew is to be used for the maintenance of truck and spraying equipment. This additional \$50.00 increase in local participation having become necessary on account of reduction in the funds available for this work.

BE it further resolved that all fees that have been collected and will be collected hereafter for this cooperative malaria control program be placed in a malaria fund and earmarked for malaria control work only.

AND, finally, be it resolved, that the State Department of Health be furnished a copy of this resolution.
