Petition to Add Territory to Hog
Law Territory

HEMPHILL, TEXAS

SEPTEMBER 16th, 1947.

TO THE HONORABLE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS:

We, the undersigned, constituting a majority of the owners of the hereinafter described lands, wherein there are residing less than twenty freeholders, which land adjoins territory over which a stock law now prevails, and in which hogs, sheep and goats are not permitted to run at large, hereby petition your honorable body to include the following lands in said stock law territory, and that you pass an order extending the stock law forbidding the running at large of hogs, sheep and goats, to include such lands, said lands so requested to be included in said stock law being described by metes and bounds as follows:

BEGINNING at the point where the center of the United States Highway No. 96 crosses the Popano creek; thence up said Creek with its meanders to the point where Sand Creek empties into said Popano Creek from the west side; thence up said Sand Creek with its meanders to the point where said creek crosses the south line of the City of Pineland, Texas and the north line of Block No. 31 of the L. F. Bacon Subdivision; thence with the north line of said Block No. 31 and of Block No. 30 of the Bacon Subdivision and the south line of the City of Pineland, Texas N 77 W to the east line of the right of way of the G. B. & G. N. Ry, Co. being the N. W. corner of said Block No. 30; thence N 13 E with the east right of way line of said railway 54 vrs; thence West 33-1/3 vrs to a point in the center line of the right of way of said G B & G N Ry Co; thence N 77 W 722 vrs to the southwest corner of the City of Pineland, Texas, being also the S. W. corner of the original town of Pineland, Texas; thence N 13 E with the west line of the City of Pineland, Texas to the point where said west line of said City crosses the center line of the Asphalt Highway spur leading from U. S. Highway No. 96 to the City of Pineland, Texas in the east line of the H. G. Osborn tract of land; thence west with the center line of said highway spur to the center of the U. S. Highway No. 96; thence southerly following the center line of U. S. Highway No. 96 to the place of beginning.
