TO THE HONORABLE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS:

We, the undersigned, constituting a majority of the owners of the hereinafter described lands herein, and there residing less than twenty freeholders, which land adjoins territory under which a stock law now prevails, and in which hogs, sheep and goats are not permitted to run at large, hereby petition this honorable body to include the following lands in said stock law territory; and that you pass an order extending the stock law forbidding the running at large of hogs, sheep and goats, to include such lands, said lands so requested to be included in said stock law being described by metes and bounds as follows:

Beginning at the point where the center line of U. S. highway No. 96, crosses the South line of the Larkin Groce League, Thence about North 76 West on the South line of said Larkin Groce League and the South line of the Ben Lindsey League, to the South East corner of 2.8 acres owned by Paul and Lilly Machac; Thence N. 15 E. 128 vrs. to the North East corner of said 2.8 acres; Thence Westerly with road to the North West corner of said 2.8 acres; Thence S. 15 W. 128 vrs. to the South line of said Ben Lindsey League; Thence N. 76 W. with the South line of said Ben Lindsey League to the Sabine and San Augustine County Line; Thence Northerly with said Sabine and San Augustine County line to the South line of the Mrs. S. J. McNeill 200 acres tract in the North West corner of said Lindsey League; Thence S. 76 E. to the South East corner of said 200 acres; Thence N. 15 E. to the North East corner of said 200 acres on the North Line of said Lindsey League; Thence S. 76 E. with the North line of said Lindsey League to the South West corner of the C. W. Easley Survey;

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Thence about N. 15 E. with the West line of said C. W. Easley Survey to its North West corner; Thence S. 76 E. with the North line of said Easley Survey to its North East corner on the West line of the Larkin Groce League; Thence S. 15 W. with the West line of said Larkin Groce League to the South West corner of the H. F. Osborne 54 acres in the West line of said Larkin Groce League; Thence S. 76 E. with Osborne's South line to the center line of U. S. Highway No. 96; Thence Westerly following the center line of U. S. Highway No. 96, to the place of beginning.
